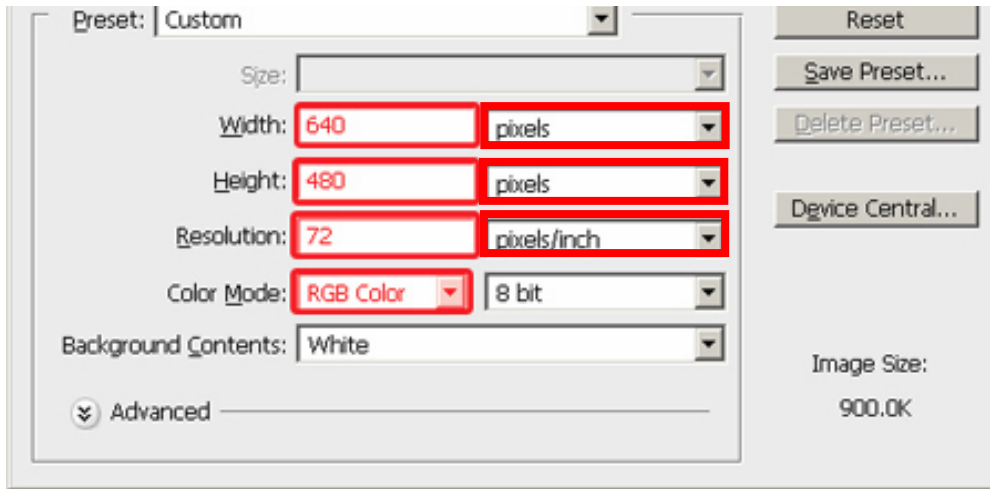

1. Open Photoshop

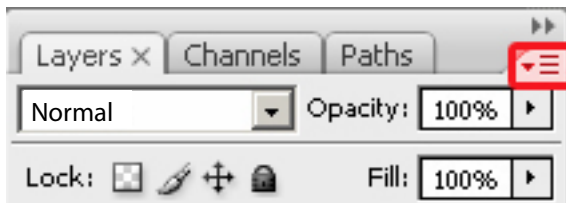
2. Create a new document that is 640 pixels wide by 480 pixels tall



3. On the Layers palette, click on the New Layer button

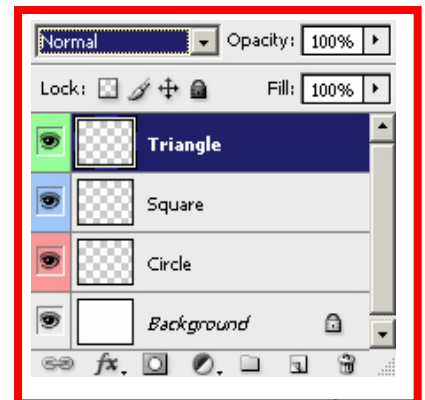


4. Click on the "Layers Options" tab



5. Select Layer Properties on the drop-down menu

6. Rename the layer "Circle" and change it's color to "red"



7. Redo steps 3 – 6, making a layer for a Square (colored blue) and a Triangle (colored green)

8. Select the Circle layer

9. Use the Elliptical Marquee tool to draw a circle

10. Use the Paint Bucket to drop red paint inside the circle

11. Select the Square layer

12. Use the Rectangle Marquee tool to draw a square

13. Use the Paint Bucket to drop blue paint inside the square. Click on "Select" from the menu and then click on "Deselect"

14. Select the Triangle layer

15. Select the pen tool on the tool bar



16. Draw a triangle on the Triangle layer. What you will draw will appear to be a simple line drawing of a triangle.

17. Select the "Direct Selection" arrow (underneath the pen tool - the white arrow) on the tool bar

18. Right click on the Triangle "path" that you made with the pen tool and select "Make Selection". This will create a "selection" (marching ants) around the triangle perimeter

19. Use the Paint Bucket to drop green paint in the triangle

20. Click on the menu item labeled "Select", then choose "Deselect" on the drop down menu.

21. Click on the "Layers Options" tab on the Layers Palette

22. Select "Palette Options" at the bottom of the drop down menu.

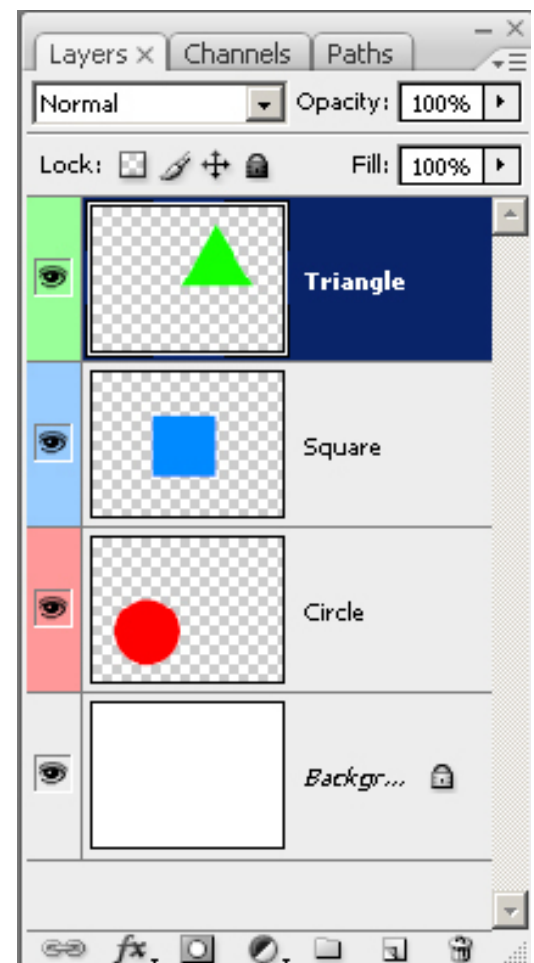
23. Choose the largest "Thumbnail" image. This will increase the image on the layers palette, making them easier to see.
